Salute To The Red, White And Blue

In 1885, BJ Cigrand, a Wisconsin school teacher arranged for the pupils in his district to celebrate the 108th anniversary of the official adoption of the stars and stripes. Cigrand enthusiastically advocated to observe June 14 as "Flag Birthday" or "Flag Day" every year. Many schools throughout the region also began to mark the anniversary.

Inspired by decades of celebrations, Flag Day was officially established by the Proclamation of President Woodrow Wilson in May of 1916. On August 3rd, 1949, President Truman signed an Act of Congress thereby designating June 14th of each year as National Flag Day.

- When the flag is displayed from the same flagpole with another flag, of a state, community or society, the flag of the United States must always be at the top. The church pennant may be flown above the flag during church services for Navy personnel when conducted by a Navel chaplain on a ship at sea.
- When displayed with other flags, none may be larger than the U.S flag.
- The United States flag is always the first flag raised and the last to be lowered. It is saluted as it is hoisted and lowered.
- It should be illuminated if displayed at night.
- The flag should never touch anything beneath it, such as ground, the floor, water or merchandise.
- Never display the union (the stars) down unless as a signal of dire distress.
- When a flag becomes worn and no longer suited for public display the United States flag code requires it to be disposed of respectfully, preferably by burning.

Washington, officially the State of Washington, joined the Union on November 17, 1889. Known by the nickname, The Evergreen State, recorded a population in 2018, of 7,536 million. The state bird is the American Goldfinch. The state flower is the Pacific Rhododendron.

There are 86 credit unions with headquarters in Washington state. 4 million members are served at 550 branch locations.
