Money matters



Crane and Co., a Massachusetts based company, has been providing the U.S. Bureau of Engraving and Printing with paper for U.S. currency since 1879.

Federal Reserve notes are a blend of 25 percent linen and 75 percent cotton. Currency paper has tiny red and blue synthetic fibers of various lengths evenly distributed throughout.

It would take 4,000 double folds, forward and backwards to tear a banknote.

No matter the denomination, the weight of a banknote is approximately 1 gram.

The Bureau of Engraving and Printing allots \$826.7 million to print cash each year. The Monopoly game people, print around \$50 billion worth in game money annually.


