Great SHAKE OUT Earthquake Drill

Since November 2008, participants of the Great Shake Out earthquake drill have been practicing to Drop, Cover, Hold. Over 11 million people last year took part in learning the four basic steps of earthquake preparedness.

- 1.) Secure your space and identify hazards and moveable items.
- 2.) Plan a safe disaster plan and decide how to communicate in an emergency.
- 3.) Organize disaster supplies and locations.
- 4.) Minimize.

Staff at the credit union will once again practice our disaster recovery plan. Each year we not only practice keeping ourselves and each other safe, we also secure credit union records. We work hard at ensuring member information is always kept safe, particularly during an emergency.
